March Sermons

Sunday, March 4 Romans 4: 13-25 "You're Not Good Enough" The story of Abraham and Sarah stands as the background to this reading from the New Testament book of Romans and it's assertion that the only way to God is through faith.

Sunday, March 11 Psalm 19 "The Language of God" From the very large to the very small, the Psalm insists that the entire creation is telling the glory of God. What is this language and how can we learn to speak it in order to find our place in God's creation?

Sunday, March 18 *Psalm* 107: 1-3, 17-22 "The Blame Game" When faced with pain or trouble, it is human behavior to attempt to assign blame. This Psalm teaches that while assigning blame may not always be an easy task, the source of healing and deliverance is simple. Learn how to escape the blame game in this ancient poem.

Sunday, March25 *Jeremiah 31: 31-34* "The Unwritten Law" This prophecy from Jeremiah speaks of a new covenant which would move God's law from the book to the heart. God would no longer be a subject to be taught, but a friend to be known.
