## QHBC Outdoor Service Guidelines

1. The following safety protocols are in place in accordance with the guiding principles set forth on reopen Connecticut Guidance. These protocols are necessary to protect everyone, our members, our church our community.

a. Isolation plan – Any attendee that becomes ill with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 shall be isolated immediately. The attendee may isolate in their car with windows closed or in the teller's room (last classroom behind the church office.)

b. Social distancing – Attendees shall remain 6 feet apart, excluding immediate family or household members.

c. Personal protection – All attendees shall wear a face mask that completely covers the mouth and nose.

d. Distance markers – markers will be placed around the tent / and service area to assist in maintaining social distancing. Those in at risk categories are encouraged to park their cars close to the tent and enjoy the service from the comfort of their vehicle.

e. Log for potential contact tracing. All attendees shall be recorded on an event log by assigned ushers to support contract tracing should a member be diagnosed with COVID-19. The log for each event shall kept by the church clerk.

f. Entry and Exit plan- There will be a one-way entry and exit plan, anyone entering or exiting the tent area is expected to follow the arrows for entry and exit.

g. All door handles, bathrooms and touch points are to be cleaned before and after each event. A log will be used to record the cleaning of each bathroom, and common area with multiple touch points (i.e... Door handles.)

h. Each outdoor service has a maximum capacity of no more than 50 people.
