<sup>1</sup> Paul, Silas and Timothy,  
To the church of the Thessalonians in God the  
Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:  
Grace and peace to you. <sup>2</sup> We always thank God  
for all of you and continually mention you in our  
prayers. <sup>3</sup> We remember before our God and  
Father your work produced by faith, your labor
