SCRIPTURES

Deuteronomy 6:1-9 NIV

These are the commands, decrees and laws the Lord your God
directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are
crossing the Jordan to possess, 2 so that you, your children and
their children after them may fear the Lord your God as long
as you live by keeping all his decrees and commands that I
give you, and so that you may enjoy long life. 3 Hear, Israel,
and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that

you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the Lord, the God of your ancestors, promised you. 4 Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. 6 These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children. Hebrews 9:11-14 NIV

11 But when Christ came as high priest of the good things that are now already here, he went through the greater and more perfect tabernacle that is not made with human hands, that is to say, is not a part of this creation. 12 He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption. 13 The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. 14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!
