READING OF THE WEEK:

We are living in a missionary age. The missionary movement has grown to awaken hope and ignite enthusiasm in the coldest and most lifeless people. The danger, however, is that the missionary movement will move ahead of the missionary Spirit. This has always been the danger of the church: losing the substance in the shade, losing the Spirit, and being satisfied with proclaiming the movement, but not putting the Spirit in the movement.
